Sir.

With reference to G.O.No.672 Law (Education) dated 11-5-23 sanctioning the introduction of painting as a Vocational subject in the Government High School, Tiruvalur, as an experimental measure for a period of 1 year from 1st July 1923, I have the honour to report that the class was opened on 11-7-23 with 33 pupils of the High School and 24 students of the training school. Subsequently the strength rose to 35 and 25 respectively.

2. After the transfer of the Secondary Training Section to Tanjore in June last, instruction in painting was given

to the

(P.T.O)

to the High School pupils alone up to 4-8-24.

From 5-8-24, however, the class had to be closed owing to the absence on leave of the Senior Drawing Master who was teaching the subject and the class has ceased to work since then.

3. As the school is to be transferred to the Municipal management, both the District Educational Officer and the Adviser to Government on Manual & Vocational Training, Teachers' College, Saidapet, are of opinion that the class need not be continued during the rest of the year.

4. As the sanction accorded in G.O.No.672 Law (Education) dated 11-5-24 expired by 30-6-24, I request that it may be considered to have been extended up to the end of 4-8-24.
