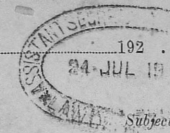

With reference to G.O.No.Mis.1044 Law(Education) dated 19- 6- 25, I have the honour to enquire whether Miss.McLeod may be considered to have retired with effect from 27th March 1925. The Accountant General, Madras whom I consulted in the matter, has stated vide his letter No.G.A.70-1032 dated 15- 7- 25(copy enclosed) that unless Miss.McLeod chooses to return to the Indian Educational service in Madras, which is a very remote possibility, the post held by her can be regarded as having been permanently vacated.

It is understood from the copy of the letter
of the Colonial office dated 30- 4- 25 to Miss.R.Mac.
Leod that her services have been transferred to the
service of the Ceylon Government with effect from 27-3-25
from which date her leave in the British Government
will be deemed to have terminated.

It will be seen from the India office letter
dated 30- 4- 25 attached to G.O.No.1044 Law(Education)
dated 19- 6- 24 that Miss.Mc.Leod received pension from
the Indian Revenues at the reduced rate from 27-3-25
and her case appears therefore to be one of re-employment
of a pensioner under the Ceylon Government. In the
circumstances, unless Miss.Macleod chooses to return
to the Indian Educational Service in Madras, which
is a very remote possibility, the post held by her,
can be regarded as having been permanently vacated.

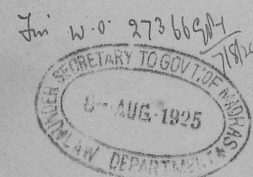
