Copy of letter dated 22nd April 1925 from the Correspondent

Y.M.C.A. School of Commerce to the District Educational Officer, Madras.

I am writing to inform you that our Board of Directors at their meeting on April 8th decided that it was advisable to close our school of Commerce. We are taking this step after considerable deliberation. We find that the Y.M.C.A. cannot continue to operate the school without considerable financial loss and as the courses offered are available either at the Government Institute of Commerce ~~across~~ the street or else where in Madras, we feel that we are merely duplicating the courses offered elsewhere.
