Under the powers delegated to me in G.O.No.180 Financial dated 21st February 1923, I sanctioned for a period of one year the appointment of a Secondary grade Assistant for the Government Madrasa-i-Azam to be in charge of the additional section of Form III, which had to be opened last year, on account of the strength of the class increasing to 54. The sanction expires on the 13th August 1925 and I have the honour to request that Government will be pleased to sanction the continuance of the Secondary grade Assistant for a further

further period of one year from the 14th August 1925  
in the circumstances explained here under.

2. The present strength of the various classes  
of the Middle School Department is as follows.

3. For the 9 sections of the Middle school  
Department, 9 Secondary Grade teachers are admissible  
under Rule 17 of the Madras Educational Rules. But the  
sanctioned scale of staff is only 7 Secondary grade  
Assistants(excluding the temporary Assistant now  
recommended for retention). The graduate Assistants  
sanctioned for the school cannot be spared for the work  
of the Lower forms. It will be observed therefore  
that the temporary Secondary grade Assistant is  
absolutely necessary.

4. Provision for the continuance of the post  
has been made in the Budget Estimate for 25- 26.

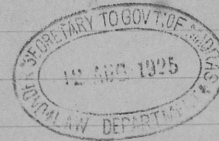

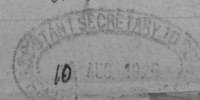
