Sir,

I have the honour to state that to finish the account of the littoral fauna of Korusadai Island, which is being ~~pre~~ prepared for publication as approved by Government in G.O. No. 1579-Misc. Law (Education) dated 11th October 1924, it will be necessary for me to visit the island again in September, and to make ~~stronger~~ a longer stay than before as my object this time is not so much to collect material as to study it under living conditions in the light of the investigations that I have now made on the preserved material previously collected. I propose to start on the 30th August and

I hope to get back before the end of September probably about ^{the} 25th. I have therefore to request you to grant me the necessary sanction to proceed to the Island on duty and to draw the travelling allowance and the usual halting allowance admissible under the Madras Travelling Allowance Rules. The expenditure involved will be met from the provision for 'Travelling Allowance' in the Museum Budget for the current year.

The Personal Assistant will as usual be put in charge of the current duties of the office.
