Exemption from examination qualification.

I have the honour to invite a reference to G.O.No. 511
Mls. Law (Education), dated 16th April 1924, in which Clerk
N. Amman of the Port Office, Mangalore, was exempted from
Examination Rules, so as to enable him to hold appointments
on pay not exceeding Rs. 80/- per mensem.

At the time when his exemption was sanctioned, the
pay of the Head Clerks of out-port offices and of the
corresponding grade in the Presidency Port Office, was
the same viz., Rs. 60 - 4 - 80, the clerks in Madras
office then getting a City Allowance of Rs. 5/- per mensem.
The rate of pay of the latter has been subsequently altered

to

to Rs. 65-4-85, abolishing the City Allowance, Vide G.O. No. 212, Finance (Marine), dated 29-4-1924. It is therefore proposed to exempt clerk, N. Amman up to Rs. 85/- per mensem, in order that he may hold appointments of the corresponding grade in the Madras office.

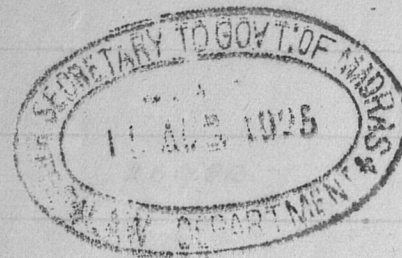
3. A vacancy has now arisen in the Madras office to which, I have appointed N. Amman, in the grade of Rs. 65-4-85. I request that Government be pleased to sanction his exemption with effect from the date he joins the Madras office.
