Copy of a letter dated the 23rd May 1925, from the Societe Royale Belge de Geographie, Belgium, to His Excellency the Viceroy and Governor General of India.

Our "Society" is gathering a collection, as complete as possible, of drawings made by children of all races and of different ages, with a view of furthering studies on comparative psychology. As yet, we have already received from several countries documents of the highest importance.

We beg to request your kind help in this matter, in order namely that we may get drawings by children born in India, and principally by those belonging to the native races of that country.

We consider as particularly interesting and suited to our purpose drawings that are conceived and executed either entirely freely, either under a suggestion of a very plain theme, appealing however to the mind of the child (pictures of his plays, his fears, his notions on the comical side of things, his nursery-tales, etc.)

A short explanatory notice by the teacher would be very useful. Hoping that our scientific endeavours will meet with your encouragement, we thank you, and have the honour to be,

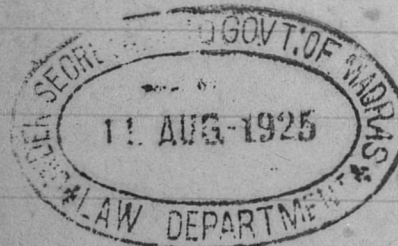
