With reference to G.O.No. 1032, Law (Education) dated 19th June 1925, I have the honour to report that the Deputy Inspector of Schools appointed to assist the Special Officer in scrutinising the maps and registers embodying the particulars gathered during the recent educational survey, joined duty on the afternoon of the 27th June 1925. A statement showing the progress of work in the scrutiny of the survey records is submitted herewith. It will be seen therefrom that the records of 183 Taluks have been examined up to date and that the records of 15 Taluks have still to be examined while the maps and registers have not yet been received in respect of 22 taluks. Urgent reminders are being issued to the District Educational Officers and

The Special Staff can continue to be employed till 31.8.25 under the sanction conveyed in G.O. 1032/25 (H)

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the Deputy Inspectors concerned asking them to expedite the submission of the records.

2. The District Educational Officers were asked to examine and report on the possibilities of expansion of elementary education through aided agencies and proposals for the opening of Board and aided schools in the areas of all the Taluk Boards, cess levying as well as non-cess levying based on the results of the survey and on the reports of the District Educational Officers have been submitted to Government in my letter C.No. 1484 B/25, dated 9th July 1925.

Supplementary Report to be submitted to the Dep. Commr.
Districtwar reports on the results of the educational survey are now being compiled by the Special Officer under my instructions. A scheme for the introduction of compulsory Elementary Education for boys in the Saidapet Taluk is also being drawn up by the Special Officer for submission to Government to be included as a Part II scheme for 1926-27.

3. Printed copies of the Report on the Guntur District were submitted to Government with my letter No. 184 B/25 dated 17th July 1925 and copies were sent at the same time to the President, District Educational Council, Guntur, Presidents of the District and Taluk Boards, the District Collector with spare copies for Tahsildars and the District Educational Officer and the Inspectress of Girls' Schools with spare copies for the Subordinate Inspecting officers.

The reports of the 8 districts mentioned in the margin

Chingleput, Chittoor, North
Arcot, the Nilgiris and Salem and sent to the Government Press.

4. The work of scrutinizing the records and compiling the districtwar reports is expected to be finished by the 31st August 1925. It is proposed thereafter to compile a consolidated report for the whole Presidency on the results of the Survey and have sufficient number of copies of it printed at the Government Press for supply free of cost to all Legislative Council members and Associations interested

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in education, such as the Missionary Educational Council of South India and the Muhammadan Educational Association. I request that Government will be pleased to approve the proposal.
