Sir.

A. Srinivasa Ayyangar, permanent Head Clerk, Government College, Kumbakonam, on Rs.35-60 passed his B.A. degree examination in September 1924 and the Principal of the College raised his pay to Rs.45 permensem with effect from 20-11-24 with reference to G.O.No.1025 Finance dated 14-10-1921 and G.O.No.74 Finance dated 21-1-22. The Accountant-General at first objected to the enhancement of the clerk's salary in his letter No.A.B.K.32/Tanj., dated 9th February 1925 but withdrew this objection when the Principal quoted the authority under which the concession was given. Similarly in 1922 when C. Raghunathan,

III Clerk,

III Clerk, Office of the District Educational Officer, Madras, applied for the grant of the concession under the above G.Os. on securing the B.A. degree, the Accountant-General was consulted as to whether the claim was admissible. He replied that the concession claimed might be given under the conditions laid down in the last two sentences of the second G.O. quoted above, vide his letter No.P.A.1 (T2.Edn)-23 dated 15th July 1922. Thus G.O.No.1025 Finance dated 14-10-1921 was made applicable to the cases of clerks who passed the B.A. degree examination after their entertainment with the approval of the Accountant-General and the provisions of the G.O. were further extended to 2 of my office clerks also, following the above precedent and no objection to this was then raised by the Accountant-General. He has, however, now raised an objection in the case of A.Srinivasa Ayyangar and required the refund of the amount already drawn with reference to the Government Memorandum, Finance Department, No.9007 E.R. dated 26-3-1925. The question at issue is whether the Government Memorandum should be taken to have retrospective effect and a refund required from clerks who were given a concession which was apparently in order prior to the issue of the Memorandum. The matter is clear so far as the pay to be drawn subsequent to the date of the Government Memorandum is concerned, but orders are requested as to whether the ruling laid down in Government Memorandum No.9007 E.R. dated 26-3-1925, Finance Department, should have retrospective effect or not - in other words whether the clerks concerned should refund the excess pay drawn by them from the date on which they were granted the concession up to the date of the Government Memorandum. The amounts involved are as follows:-

The clerks concerned have been ordered not to draw the concession rate for the future. It is recommended that, if rules admit, the amounts drawn prior to the issue of the Government Memorandum of 26th March 1925 be waived. I would at the same time venture to point out that while clerks without experience who are graduates can be allowed the concession permitted in G.O.No.1025 Finance, dated 14-10-1921 and G.O.No.74 Finance, dated 21-1-1922, clerks with some experience who subsequently improve their qualifications can only draw a lower rate of pay.

In reply to your letter No.1354-C/22 dated the 4th July 1922, enquiring whether M.R.Ry., C.Raghunathan, Clerk, Office of the Inspector of Schools, Madras and Chingleput Districts, may be permitted to draw Rs.50/- per mensem from the date of his passing B.A.degree examination, I have the honour to state that there is no audit objection to the concessions being granted to him, provided the conditions laid down in the last two sentences of the G.O. 74 Finance dated 21-1-22 are satisfied.

Finance, d/ 26th March 1925 restricting
the highest rates of pay to clerks who

An analogous case in the Registration Dept.
was disposed of in G.O. No. 591 Finance, d/
13th July 1925. The present case may also
