The S.G.P. has raised the question of reprinting the rules under the Children Act in the linked file nos. As the rules are to be revised after with the transfer of control of the

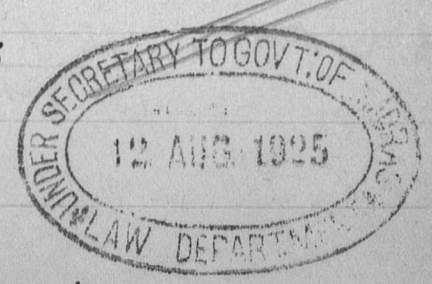
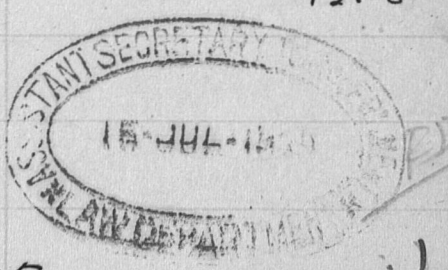

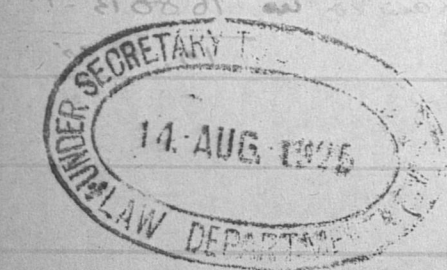

It may be mentioned that ~~the~~ ^{with Rules} the Co-operative Societies Act and the State Aid to Industries Act ^{with Rules} were issued not in this Dept but in the administrative Dept concerned, namely Development. Attention is also requested to the portion marked A at p.1. of the note on publication work submitted to the Secy. The work in this section is very heavy already. In the circumstances

mentioned above, Law (Education) may be requested to take up the work of issuing this publication.
