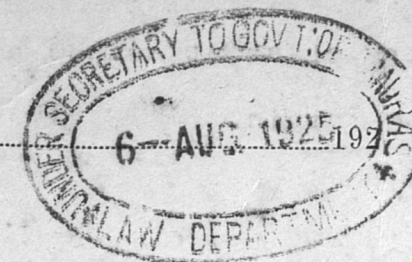

Sir,

I have the honour to submit below a scheme for the introduction of weaving and carpentry in the Wesleyan Mission Higher Elementary School, Dharapuram.

2. Instruction in carpentry is proposed to be given to about 15 pupils in batches of 3 each and in weaving to about 60 pupils in 5 batches of 12 each - each batch receiving instruction for 2 periods of 3 hours every week.

3. The Adviser to Government on Manual and Vocational Training who scrutinised the scheme estimates

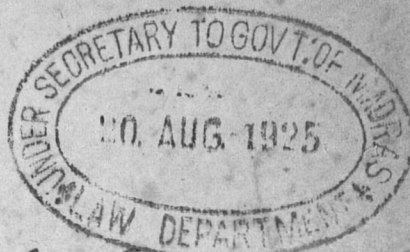
