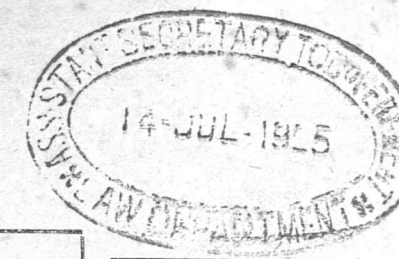

Sir,

As stated in para 5 of my letter R.O.C.No.871-A/24, dated 10-1-25, read in G.O.No.210 Mis., Law (Education) dated 10-2-25, I have the honour to address Government re: the ~~xxx~~ employment of an Assistant Mechanic and Electrician in the Presidency College.

The workshop machinery sanctioned for the College in the G.O. quoted above has since been purchased and fitted up. It is reported that the work in the workshop has increased considerably and it has become too heavy for the single

single mechanic now looking after the work. Further, as the workshop has been better equipped and more students will work therein, the need of an Assistant Mechanic who will also be an electrician to look after the College battery and the electrical fittings is said to be keenly felt.

Besides, the storage battery in the College, it is reported, has to be charged more often now than in previous years owing to the increased strength of the practical classes and the increased facilities that have been provided in the lecture room for demonstrations. The workshop staff at present consists of a single mechanic who is helped occasionally in his miscellaneous work by one of the attenders and in looking after the battery on charge days by another attender. Owing to the increased work in the various sections in the laboratory, the attenders can spare very little time to help the mechanic for the above purpose. An Assistant Professor ^{has} often to look after the charging and to do the work on holidays and he is thereby deprived of time which could be devoted to more useful and intelligent work in the laboratory. Hence an Assistant to the Mechanic has become an urgent necessity.

I, accordingly, request sanction for his appointment with effect from 1-8-25. The pay recommended is Rs.40-2-60 which is also the scale sanctioned for Mechanics in other Arts and Professional Colleges. The scale of pay of the present Mechanic in the Presidency College is 65-5-95.

The additional expenditure involved by the proposal amounts to Rs.280 (7 x 40) during the current year and it can be met from the anticipated savings under "31.A(b)(i)-Education-University-Government Arts Colleges-Pay of Establishments" in the Civil Budget Estimate for 1925-26.

I solicit the favour of very early orders.

Note for the Finance Committee

Employment of ^{and} assistant mechanic and electrician in the Presidency College - Proposal of the D.P.I. Proposal of Mr. D. P. S.

Early in 1925 the Director of Public Instruction reported that the ~~work~~ work in the workshop of the Physics department of the Presidency College had ^{expanded} ~~increased~~ considerably owing:-

- to larger admissions to the science sections of the B.A. and the Intermediate classes,
- to the admission of research students to the Physics department and
- to the regular workshop training given to the Honours students.

He therefore recommended that the workshop should be equipped on up-to-date lines by the purchase of certain items of machinery. The purchase of these was sanctioned in February 1925.

2 The machinery has since been fitted up. There is only one mechanic in the workshop ^{and} ~~The~~ the work in the ~~shop~~ ^{work} is found too much for a single ~~him~~ mechanic. Besides the workshop, the mechanic has also to attend to the storage battery in the college. It is reported that the battery has to be charged more often now than in ~~the~~ ^{in the} previous years owing to the increased ^{in the} strength of the practical classes and the increased facilities that have been ^{are} provided in the lecture rooms for demonstration. Hitherto, the mechanic used to be helped by one or ~~the~~ other ~~of~~ the attenders. Owing to the expansion of work in the various sections in the laboratory, ~~the~~ ^{no} the attenders can spare ~~very little~~ time to help the mechanic in the discharge of the work connected with ~~the battery~~. The assistant professor has often to look after the charging of the battery and to do the work on holidays and he is thereby deprived of the time which could be devoted to more useful and intel-

intelligent work in the laboratory. ~~hence~~ An assistant to the mechanic has ^{therefore} become an urgent necessity. He may be given a pay of Rs 40-2-60 which is the scale sanctioned for mechanics in the mufassal colleges. The assistant may be employed with effect from the 1st August 1925 and the extra cost in the current year which amounts to Rs 280 can be met from ~~the~~ savings in the provision for Government Arts Colleges in the current year's budget.

Note by the Law (Education) Department

In 1922 the Government issued orders increasing the admissions ^{to} the college from 107 to 180 in the Junior Intermediate class and from 111 to 216 in the Junior B.A. class. The increased enrolment ^{has} necessitated the working of the Intermediate science classes in two batches. The Director has made out a case for the employment of an assistant to the mechanic ^{involving an ultimate extra cost of Rs 627 a year.} and the proposal is recommended for acceptance.

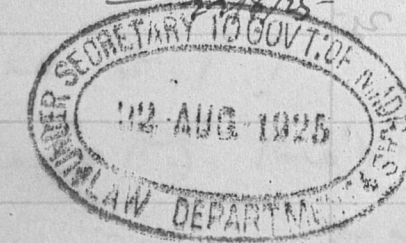
