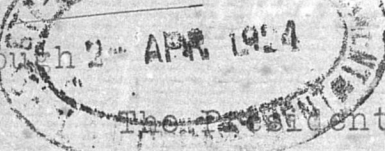

Subject:- Balance of provincial subsidy - application.

With reference to the Memorandum No. 2336-5-P.H. dated 26th February 1924 of the Government of Madras Local and Municipal and in continuation of my R.O.C. 2368/23 dated 28-11-23, I have the honour to report as follows:-

2. Out of the total sum of Rs. 38926 (Balance due as per G.O. No. 1448 Law Education dated 29-11-22 and G.O. No. 96, dated 17-1-23 Rs. 7731-0-0 plus Rs. 31195 under proviso to section 37 is equal to Rs. 38926) due from Government, the amounts noted in the *margin* have been adjusted towards the credit of this Board. Thus a sum of Rs. 7755-0-0 (Rs. 38926 -

Memorandum No.23336-5 P.H., dated the 26th February 1924.

Claims against the Government - Delay in presentation.

The attention of all local bodies is invited to paragraph 17 of the Madras Treasury Manual Volume I which lays down the maximum period after the expiry of which adjustments between Provincial and local funds are not permitted. A number of instances have recently come to the notice of the Government in which local bodies have failed to claim the grants due to them in proper time and the special sanction of the Government to their disbursement was applied for. The Government desire to impress on all local bodies the necessity for a strict observance of the rule in future and they hereby warn them that no such arrear claims will be entertained after the 1st April 1924 under any circumstances.

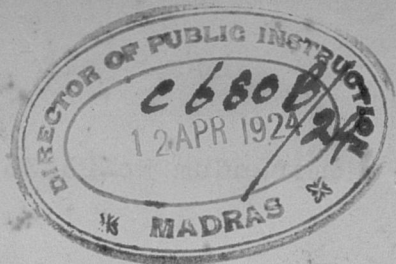

Sir.

In resubmitting herewith letter R.O.C.No.25-G/24 dated 23-3-24 from the President, Taluk Board, Sivakasi, referred to me for remarks in Government Endorsement No.1417 A-1 dated 11-4-24, I have the honour to state that at first, it was pointed out to the President, Taluk Board, that no balance of subsidy is due to the Board towards the maintenance of Elementary Schools as per G.O.No.1448 Law (Education) dated 29-11-22. The President's contention is that under the proviso to Section 37 of the Act, Government are to contribute from 21-22 the actual recurring expenditure incurred from Provincial funds in 1920-21 on the maintenance of elementary schools. The actual recurring expenditure

is reported to be Rs.27,115/- and since Government have sanctioned only the usual recurring subsidy (Rs.24,331) till 1924-25, a balance of Rs.7,224 is now claimed by the President.

2. It was pointed out to the President that under the orders of Government the actual recurring expenditure incurred from provincial funds in 1920-21 was paid till 1924-25 only to those local bodies which levied the Education-cess and in the case of other local bodies the usual recurring subsidy was paid.

From 1924-25, subsidies payable to all local bodies for elementary education have been fixed with reference to the actual recurring expenditure incurred from provincial funds in 1920-21 as required under the proviso to Section 37, whether they levy the cess or not. Accordingly the Provincial contribution payable under the proviso to Section 37 to the Taluk Board, Sivakasi, has been fixed at Rs.23,885 in G.O.No.1121 Law (Education) dated 10-7-24, as that was the figure reported by the President. Therefore, the President's claim for the balance of Rs.7,224 from 1921-22 (not Rs.7,755) is inadmissible.

3. But, it is observed that there is a difference in the figures reported by the President in regard to the actual recurring expenditure. It was once reported to ~~xxx~~ be Rs.23,885 and that figure was taken as the Provincial contribution in G.O. No.1121 Law (Education) dated 10-7-24. It is now reported that the sum of Rs.23,885/- represents only the Provincial subsidy received in 1920-21, whereas the actual recurring expenditure was Rs.27,115, the excess being met from the unspent balance of previous years. The sum of Rs.27,115 now reported includes Rs.2,675, the expenditure incurred on the temporary allowance of Rs.4. If it (Rs.2,675) is deducted (Rs.27,115 - Rs.2,675), the actual recurring expenditure in 1920-21 would be Rs.24,440/-. It has been ascertained from the Examiner of Local Fund Accounts that according to the audited figures the actual recurring

expenditure

expenditure incurred from Provincial funds in 1920-21 excluding the temporary allowance of Rs.4/- is Rs.24,416/-. Accepting the Examiner's figure, the subsidy payable to the Board from 1924-25 should be fixed at Rs.24,416 instead of Rs.23,885. The difference of Rs.531 (Rs.24,416 - Rs.23,885) for each of the years 1924-25 and 1925-26 has now to be paid to the Board. The extra expenditure (Rs.1,062) is recommended for payment from the current year's budget provision of Rs.37,02,300 under "31.(C) (c)-Education-Primary-Grants to local bodies for Primary Education- Non-voted - Recurring".
