C.G. Pakkiri Asari and T.K. Vedavyasa Rao, two
unpassed temporary draftsmen, have just been confirmed by
the Superintending Engineer, Madras Circle, in consideration
of their long and continuous service of over 13 years in the
department. As they do not possess the professional quali-
fications prescribed for draftsmen in Article 3 of the Public
Service Notification they have to be exempted from the exami-
nation rules.

2. The question of granting permanent exemption to these
two men was time and again brought forward by the Super-
intending Engineer who was told with the concurrence of the
Law (Education) Department that it might be brought forward
when there was a prospect of their obtaining permanent
appointments. They have now been provided with permanent
appointments as draftsmen. They have earned uniformly good
reports as efficient draftsmen and estimators and had to be
kept on continuously in the Ceded districts owing to the very
great difficulty experienced in finding suitable men with the
prescribed examination qualifications for employment in those
districts. C.G. Pakkiri Asari was last exempted from the
Lower subordinate test temporarily up to 31st March 1922 in
G.O., No. R 142 Law (Education), dated 13th July 1921.
T.K. Vedavyasa Rao was similarly exempted for the period of

his incumbency in the temporary post of draftsman in the Kurnool Division in G.O., No. R 223, Home (Education) dated 23rd September 1918. He has been confirmed in the Kurnool Division.

It is very desirable to retain the services of these two experienced men. It will also be a great hardship to them if they are now to be thrown out, as they have all along been given hopes of confirmation.

3. I therefore recommend that these two draftsmen may be granted permanent exemption from the Lower subordinate test of the College of Engineering Madras. Applications in the prescribed form are enclosed.

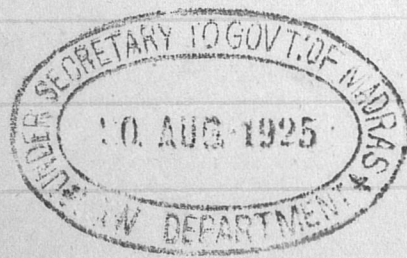
