Calendars of the Indian Universities.

Sir,

It has been brought to notice in the India Office that there is no regular procedure in force for the supply to that Office of complete sets of Indian University Calendars, and the India Office have suggested that, with a view to uniformity, the avenue of supply should be through the Office of the High Commissioner for India as in the case of Indian Official publications. Calendars are, when available, sent from that office to the India Office, but complete sets have not been available for the purpose; and in order to supplement this supply the Librarian at the India Office has recently requested several Provincial Governments and Mysore to send copies regularly direct to him. He is, however, willing that these requests for direct supply should be cancelled, and would prefer to receive all copies via the Office of the High Commissioner for India. The India Office have accordingly asked that arrangements may be made for two complete sets of all Calendars to be sent regularly to the Office of the High Commissioner for India as issued for transmission to the India Office, and that the supply of all copies at present sent direct to the India Office may be discontinued.

2. As regards the needs of the Office of the High Commissioner for India, I am to state that in November last the Indian Students' Department addressed the various Vice-Chancellors
