Sir,

I have the honour to report that one Mrs. J. Ranganayaki Ammal, was appointed as an Assistant in the Government Training School for Women, Conjeevaram, on Rs. 40 plus 12 on 7-4-21. As she was not qualified, she was recommended in my letter R.O. 203-G/22, dated 26-4-22, for permanent exemption from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification and the trained teacher's certificate examination of the Secondary grade which was granted in G.O. No. 233.R dated 12-5-22. As the date from which the exemption was to take effect was not specified in the G.O. the teacher's initial pay was fixed at Rs. 54/2 on 12-5-22 with subsequent increments. Schools, Central Circle, now states that Mrs. Ranganayaki has been officiating in the post from 7-4-21, that the post was permanently vacant from 7-4-21 and that therefore she may be confirmed in the post with effect from that date in order to enable her to count her service in the time scale from 7-4-21. I therefore recommend that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government to exempt the teacher with effect from 7-4-21 to enable her to count the period from 7-4-21 to 11-5-22 for purposes of increment. In this case the teacher's pay on 7-4-21 will be fixed at Rs. 54/- per mensem with further increments subject to the conditions laid down in G.O. No. 1497 dated 25-12-23.

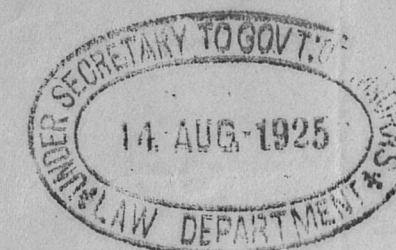

In returning herewith letter R.C.No.601-C/25, dated 30.6.1925 of the Director of Public Instruction forwarded with Government Endt.No.1728/B-1, dated 11.7.1925 for remarks, I have the honour to state that there is no objection to Mrs.Ranganayaki Ammal, Assistant Government Training School for Women, Conjeevaram being exempted from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification and the Trained Teachers' Certificate Examination of the Secondary Grade with effect from 7.4.1921. The Director of Public Instruction says in the last sentence of his letter that the teacher's pay will then be fixed at Rs.54/- from 7.4.1921. It can be fixed at Rs.52/- only on 7.4.1921 and she will become eligible for Rs.54/- from 1.3.1922.

Mrs Ranganayaki Amal was exempted from the exam rules for employment as an Asst. in the Govt Training School for Women, Conjeevaram on Rs 40, plus Rs 10 allowance. But in the order no mention was made as to ^{the date} from which ^{the date} the exemption should take effect. Though she has been acting officiating in that capacity from 7.4.21. The D. P. J. therefore fixed ^(the date from which) Rs 54 as her initial pay from 12.5.22 ^{on the} date on which exemption was sanctioned.

He now requests that she may be allowed to draw Rs 54/- from the day on which she was appointed to officiate in that post.

The A. C., who was consulted in the matter, has no objection to ^{being given effect to} the exemption from 7.4.21, but as for her pay, he says that as the time scale of pay was sanctioned from 1.3.22, she is
