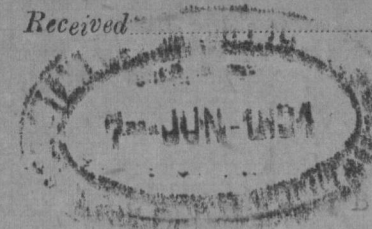

Sir,

In the scheme approved in G.O. No. 1435 Law (Education) dated 10-10-23 for the introduction of manual training in wood work in the Board High School, Aska the non-recurring charge towards "Repairs to Buildings" was estimated at Rs. 400 and Government undertook to meet from Provincial funds one-half of this charge. The President District Board, Ganjam now reports to me that the actual estimates for repairs came ^{to} Rs. 1300 and that the amount of Rs. 400 originally provided for the purpose was found to be quite inadequate to meet the charge. He therefore

therefore requests that the sanction of Government may be obtained for the payment from provincial funds of Rs.900 being one-half of the actual cost of the repairs.

2. The President says that the Board is not in a position to spend Rs.(1800-200) 1600 from its funds and that unless the repairs are completed before 16th June 1924 when the school reopens after the summer vacation the work of the training class will be seriously affected.

3. I beg to submit herewith copies of the President's letters R.C.No.614 D.B/24 dated 12-4-24 and 4-5-24 on the subject and to state that there is no provision in the Budget Estimate for 1924-25 to meet the additional amount of Rs.700 applied for by the President.

Copy of letter R.C.No.614/D.B/24 dated 12th April

1924 from the President, District Board, Ganjam.

--

I have the honour to state that in G.O.No.Mis. 1435 Law (Education) dated 10-10-23 sanctioning the introduction of Manual training in the Board High School, Aska the non-recurring charge "Repairs to building" was estimated at Rs.400 and one half of the charge was undertaken to be paid from provincial funds. But the actual estimate for repairs to the room and the adjoining verandah wherein the training class is to be held came to Rs.1800 and the amount of Rs.400 already sanctioned is quite inadequate to meet the charge. The class is at present located in a verandah as the room intended for the vocational class cannot be repaired with Rs.400.

I therefore request you to be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government to the payment of Rs.900 being one half of the charge from provincial funds towards the repairs to the building. The Board is not in a position to spend Rs.(1800-200) 1600 from its funds.

I request the favour of very early instruction in the matter so that I may put the work in execution.

Copy of letter from the President, District Board, Ganjam, R.C.No.614 /D.B/24 dated 4th May 1924.

I have the honour to invite your attention to my letter R.C.No.614/D.B/24 dated 12-4-24 and to request you to be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government to the payment of Rs.900 from provincial funds towards one-half of the charge estimated on account of repairs to the room in the Board High School Aska wherein the vocational training class is proposed to be held.

The High School at Aska will be reopened after summer vacation on 16th June 1924 and unless the repairs to the room are completed in the meanwhile the work of the training ~~vacation~~ class will be seriously affected.

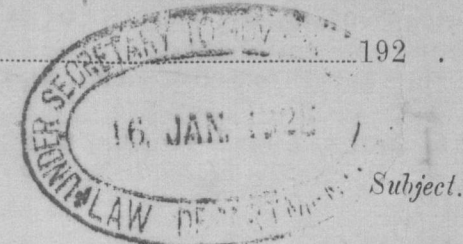

Sir.

With reference to G.O.No.1435 Law (Education) dated 10-10-23 approving the scheme for the introduction of manual training in wood work in the Board High School, Aska for a period of 1 year from 1-11-23 and sanctioning the payment to the District Board, Ganjam, of a subsidy of Rs.1,142/- during 1923-24, I have the honour to state that the President reports that the class was actually opened on 1-4-24 and that 144 pupils are receiving 2 periods of instruction per week.

2. From the statement showing the receipts and charges of the class submitted by the President (a copy of which is herein enclosed) it will be seen that no expenditure was incurred during 1923-24 and that equipment^{and} tools to the extent of Rs.1,318 have already been purchased.

3. As regards repairs to the terraced hall to be converted into a manual training class, I beg to state that the President in his subsequent letter states that the estimate has come to Rs.2,400 and requests that sanction may be obtained for the payment of one-half of the subsidy of Rs.1,200/-.

In this connection, I beg to invite attention to this office letter R.C.No.1401-D/23 dated 4-6-24. I, however, recommend a subsidy of Rs.700/- only to the District Board on this account, for want of funds.

4. In regard to recurring charges, it will be seen that the estimate comes to Rs.850/- including the salary of an Instructor at Rs.47/- per mensem.

The Adviser to Government on Manual & Vocational Training, Teachers' College, Saidapet, reports that the Instructor is the holder of a first class Vocational training diploma and that he was at first paid only Rs.35/- per mensem pending the sanction of the special pay of Rs.12 per mensem to the Instructor of the Government Training School, Chicacole, who possesses similar qualifications. He now recommends that the Instructor of the Board High School, Aska, also may be given the special allowance of Rs.12 per mensem sanctioned for Instructors holding 1st Class Manual Training diplomas and I support his recommendation that he be allowed to draw Rs.47 per mensem on the analogy of G.O.No.1626 Law (Education) dated 22-10-24.

5. If the above recommendations be approved, the subsidy payable to the District Board, Ganjam, for the maintenance of the Manual Training Class during the current year will be Rs.1,784 as

- (1) Rs.1318 Tools & Equipment.
- (2) Rs.1400 for repairs to buildings,

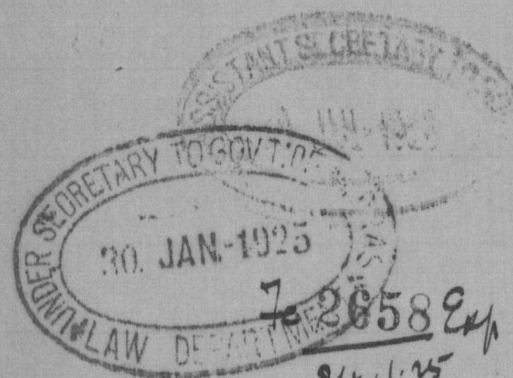
