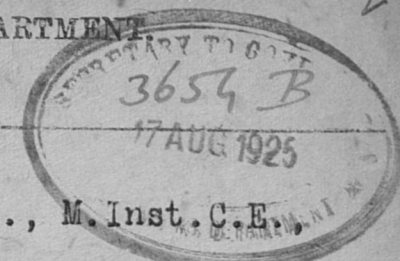

SEVEN COPIES

In G.O. No. 434-W dated 26-3-25 six permanent posts of tracers were sanctioned for the Madras Circle. Against two of the sanctioned posts, M.T. Manikka Mudaliar and M. Manikkam Chetty who had been employed as temporary tracers have been confirmed by the Superintending Engineer, Madras Circle, in view of their long service, satisfactory work and conduct in the department. They do not possess the professional qualifications prescribed for tracers in Art. 3 of the Public Service Notification, but the Superintending Engineer requests that they may be exempted from examination rules. M.T.Manikka Mudaliar has put in 15 years continuous temporary service in the department and was exempted from examination rules temporarily in G.O.No.1081-Home(Edn.) dated 8-9-19 for so long as he continued to be employed as a tracer in the old V Circle. M. Manikkam Chetty was similarly exempted in G.O.No. 1194-Home(Edn.) dated 1-10-19 and has put in 13 years continuous temporary service.

I consider that it is not desirable to lose the services of experienced men and that it will be a very great hardship to the men also if they are now to be thrown out. I therefore recommend that

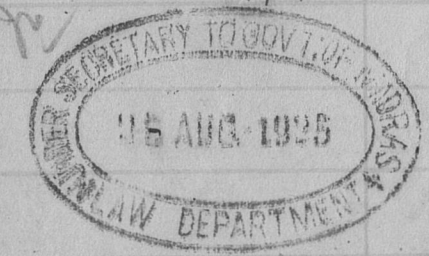
