SIR,

With reference to G.O.No. Mis.1020 dated 17-6-1925, on the above subject, I have the honour to state that the recovery of contribution is to be based on the pay drawn in ^{therefore} Foreign Service. Contribution is, ~~however~~, leviable at 25% of pay in Foreign Service in this case and not at 1/6th for the period from 28-10-1924 to the date on which he actually reverts to British Service.

2. It is open to Government to refuse to sanction the Foreign Service deputation of the attender under Fundamental Rule 111(a), but not because the Fundamental Rules do not provide for transfer of inferior service men to Foreign Service. The term used is "Government servants" simply and not "Government servants in Superior Service".

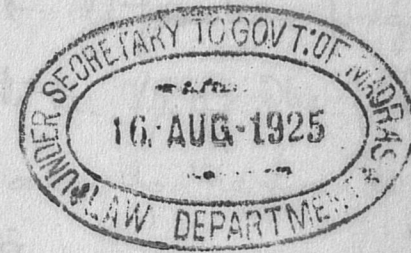

in the offices of Dy. Inspectors of Schools are on the scale Rs 15-20 and therefore inferior servants - vide Subsidiary Definition (iii) on p 9 of the Fundamental Rules. Inferior servants are ^{ordinarily} granted leave ~~any~~ without any extra cost to Govt. 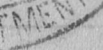

3. The words "British service" occurring in the last sentence of G.O.No. 1020 Law (Education), dated 17th June 1925, will be altered into "Foreign service".
