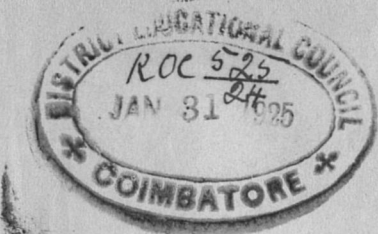
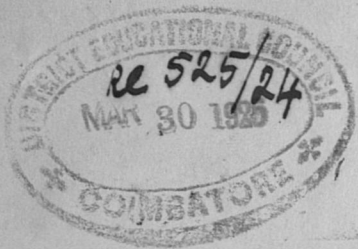
(l). In view of the difficulty experienced in getting qualified teachers, it is proposed to send for training more men next year.

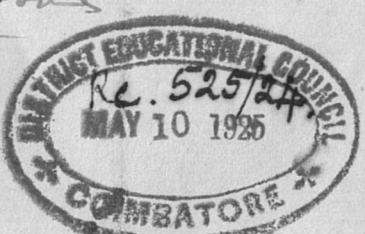
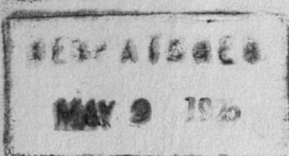
