Officiating appointments in the Indian
Educational Service.

I am directed to acknowledge receipt of your letter no.
145-Edn., dated 21st May 1925, on the above subject, and to in-
form you that after consideration of the representations sub⁹
mitted in it, the Secretary of State in Council is pleased to
accord his sanction to the action taken by the Government of
India in respect of the officiating appointments specified by you
in the Indian Educational Service.

Copy of letter no. 145-Edn., dated the 21st May 1925, from
the Secretary to the Govt. of India, Department of Education,
Health and Lands, to His Majesty's Under Secretary of State for
India, Services & General Department, India Office, London.

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I am directed to say that as in his despatch no. 169-Public
dated the 27th November 1919, the Secretary of State for India in
Council accepted the proposals of the Govt. of India, which were
submitted in para. 14 of their Financial despatch no. 255, dated
the 10th July 1919, the Auditor General has held that all pre-
vious orders in respect of the powers of local Governments and
of the Govt. of India to make officiating appointments to the
Indian Educational Service have been superseded thereby. He had
therefore advised that since the date (1st December 1919) of the

reorganisation of the Indian Educational Service the powers of local Governments and of the Govt. of India to make officiating appointments to that service are restricted to appointments lasting six months and two years respectively.

2. The local Governments and the Chief Commissioner, North West Frontier Province, were duly apprised of this decision and asked to report to the Govt. of India all cases of officiating appointments to the Indian Educational Service, whether from the Provincial Educational Service or from any other source, made by them since the 1st December 1919, for periods exceeding six months which were not covered by the orders of the Secretary of State, contained in his despatch no. 60-Finl., dated the 12th August 1920, in order that the position may be regularised. The ~~less~~ reports of local Governments are now complete and the Govt. of India have accorded their sanction to all such appointments made by local Governments and the Chief Commissioner, North West Frontier Province, for periods not exceeding two years. not
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3. Subject to your confirmation the Govt. of India have also sanctioned (i) all officiating appointments which have exceeded or are likely to exceed two years, and (ii) the continuance of certain officiating appointments in excess of two years pending relief by a permanent member of the Indian Educational Service or till effect is given to the recommendations made in para. 15 of the Report of the Royal Commissioner on the Superior Civil Services in India in respect of the Indian Educational Service, whichever is earlier. A list of these appointments is enclosed and I am to request that the Secretary of State in Council may be moved to accord his sanction to the action taken by the Govt. of India.
