Sir,

Koodapalli -- Ward - Education - Removal from Trichinopoly.

I have the honour to inform you that the Court of Wards had decided that the Koodapalli Ward should be removed from Trichinopoly and be sent either to the St. Joseph's College, Bangalore or some other institution either in Madura or Chidambaram. The Ward should be admitted to a College Hostel, the Principal acting as Honorary Guardian with powers to delegate his duties of routine supervision etc to one of his staff. The Principal of the St. Joseph's College and Principals of Colleges in Madura and Chidambaram expressed their inability to admit the ward for want of suitable hostel accommodation.

The ward now continues his studies in the National College. His name is K.S. Sabapathi Pillai and his age is 18 years. For the last two or three years it has been found somewhat difficult to control him. I have the reason to believe that he associates with persons whose influence upon him is not satisfactory.

My own impression of the boy is that he is at present thoroughly out of hand. But he seems to be somewhat young for his age and distinctly impressionable; I am sure that a taste of wholesome discipline with the athletic and a scholarly interest of a college -- hostel will do a great deal for him. I shall be obliged of you would kindly let me know the name or names of colleges outside Madras -- the court has expressed as its opinion that Madras would be unsuitable to whose Principals I am make a reference regarding the admission of the Ward. I am extremely anxious that the Ward should be admitted into a suitable College hostel from the next school year at least.
