Sir,

It is noticed from page 2 of the Public Service and Special Test Examination Notifications that the appointments of Hospital Assistants and Headkeepers in Mental Hospitals in the Medical Department are excluded from the operation of article I of the Public Service Notification vide page 2 of the Notification B - appointments excluded.

2. I consider that the necessity for the exclusion of the above appointments from the Notification does not arise for the following reasons:-

1.

(1) Hospital Assistants

This was the designation given to the present sub-assistant surgeons some years back. Presumably candidates with no minimum general educational qualification also were recruited for the course of Hospital Assistants then. But now, only those candidates who have obtained completed Secondary School Leaving Certificate or have passed any of the examinations which have been recognised by Government as equivalent to it in article 1 of the Public Service Notification are eligible for admission to the Medical Schools for the L. M. P. course. The selected candidates have to undergo 4 years training for the diploma of L.M.P. Further sub-assistant surgeons are professional men and only those who possess the diploma of L.M.P. are eligible for appointments as sub-assistant surgeons.

(2) Head keepers in Mental Hospitals

The maximum pay of the appointments of Head keepers and ordinary keepers in the three Mental Hospitals does not exceed Rs. 35 per mensem.

(3) It is therefore requested that Government will be pleased to delete the appointments of the Hospital Assistants and Head keepers in Mental Hospitals in the Medical Department from list of appointments shown in Part B of the Public Service Notification revised up to 31st May 1925.

Amendment of the Public Service Notification

Under art 2 of the Public Service Notification ¹⁹²⁴ ^{forming} the appointments in the Medical Dept have been excluded from the provisions of art 1 prescribing certain educational qualifications for ~~the~~ ^{generally} appointments.

- ① Hospital Assistants and head keepers in lunatic Asylums (Mental hospitals).
- ② Deputy Inspectors of Vaccination who are to possess only the qualifications prescribed in the Vaccination code.

(General purpose)

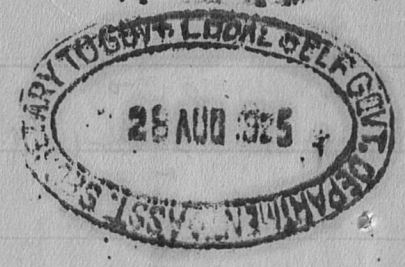
Recently some further additions have been made to the appointments in the medical Dept which are to be excluded from art 1.

The Surgeon General, for the reasons fully explained in his letter, recommends the deletion of the appointments in item ① viz Hospital Assistants & head keepers from the list. As regards 'Hospital Assistants' their pay ranges from Rs 75 - 175 with a selection grade at Rs 200 and they are also educationally qualified according to the provisions

of Art 1. The suggestion of the S.S.
to remove the appointments from the
'exempted' list may therefore be accepted. ✓

In respect of 'head keepers'
it is said their pay is ^{on scale of B} Rs 25-35.
No educational qualification is apparently
prescribed for the appointment. But
under Art I of the P.S. Notification
appointments in the inferior service on
Rs 35 & over would require mention
if the persons are not qualified educationally.

whose duties are defined in rules 374-396 of
the Code. Their pay is Rs. 20- (biennial)-25
and they are already exempted from educa-
tional qualifications under rule 376 of the Code.
The S.S.'s suggestion is that it is unnecessary

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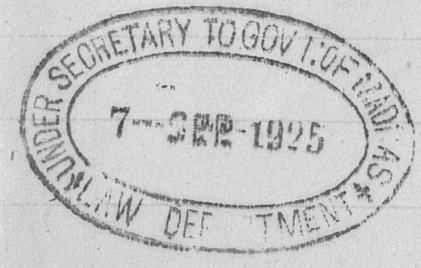
