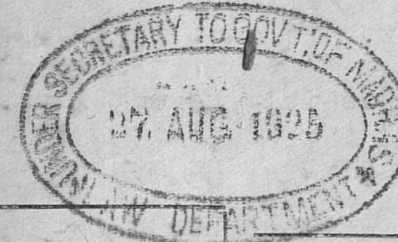

Sir,

With reference to G.O.No. 732,Mis.Law (Education) dated 8th May 1925 approving the scheme for the introduction from the beginning of the school year 1925-26 of manual training in basket weaving, Sericulture and mat-weaving in the elementary schools under the Kollegal Taluk Board, I have the honour to submit herewith copies of 2 letter received from the President, Taluk Board, Kollegal Dis No. ³⁵³ K.T.B/25, dated 12th July 1925 and R.C.No. 931 Sub/25, dated 9th August 1925 and to state that I am not prepared to support the President's request- If they cannot pay, the scheme may drop.

Copy of letter Dis No. 359 K.T.B/25, dated 12-7-1925 from the President, Taluk Board, Kollegal to this office.

② In G.O.No. 732, L.Mis., dated 8th May 1925, the Government sanctioned Rs 280/- being the moiety of the cost of introduction of Manual training in some of the elementary schools under this Board, on condition that the Taluk Board might contribute towards the said training an equal amount. This proposal was submitted to Government for approval in 1924, on the assumption that the Taluk Board can contribute Rs 280 from its general funds. After the above proposal was sent, the Government took the question of abolishing the Taluk Board, and the District Board was not in favour of it and finally it resolved to contribute to the Taluk Board Rs 15000/- a year to wipe off its deficit. To meet the ordinary expenditure under Elementary Education cannot possibly be met from the District Board contribution without effecting any retrenchment and as such the Taluk Board is not in a position to contribute Rs 280/- towards the manual training. In the circumstances stated above, I request you to kindly address the Government to meet the entire cost of training from provincial funds. If the Government refuse to bear the entire cost the amount of Rs 280/- placed by Government at my disposal will be refunded on receipt of intimation from you.
