School - Govt. Islamiah Secondary
School, Trichinopoly - Building
Improvements - Proposals -
awaited



Advisory Board of the Islamiah Secondary School,
Trichinopoly, in a regular meeting convened on 6-10-24
at 7. P.M. , have resolved to forward to Government
the following resolutions:-

I. That this Board recommend to Government, the urgent
necessity of constructing a pacca building for the said
school.

II. That for the said purpose of putting up a pacca
building S.No. 2250 be acquired at once. //

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III. That this Board draw attention of Government to
the terms of the agreement of 1917 and Transfer deed of the
Islamiah School properties, whereby the Government have
undertaken to open the High School Classes in the Islamiah
Secondary School immediately after affecting the legal
transfer of the school properties. In view of the said
transfer having been completed as early as 1923, this
Board request Government to fulfil its part of the agree-
ment by raising this institution to the status of a complete
High School in the next academic year.

IV. That in view of the growing demand for Muhammadan
Education, and in view of the fact that there is no complete
Muhammadan High School south of Madras, this Board strongly
recommend to Government , the necessity of raising this
institution to the status of a complete High School and
making it a premier institution in the south.

V. This Board while drawing attention of Government
to the remarks made by the District Educational Officer,
Trichinopoly in his latest inspection report of this school
viz., that the medium of instruction should be Tamil,
depricate such an idea, and urge upon Government the neces-

necessity of continuing Urdu as the medium of Instruction in non language subjects.

VI. This Board recommend to Government the ~~creation~~ creation of a separate post of Urdu Munshi in the Government Islamiah School in view of the fact that the mother tongue of 90 per cent of the students is Urdu.

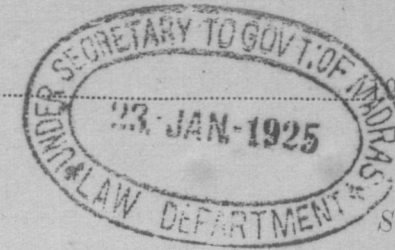

It may be mentioned here that Government did not give any undertaking that they would raise the school into a complete High School, as soon as the legal transfer of the school properties was completed. What is provided in the agreement is "that the institution should be raised to a High School when circumstances appear favourable in the near future".

Resolution No.6 - Creation of a separate post of Urdu Munshi.-

Attention is solicited to G.O.No.1762 Law (Education) dated 15-11-24 in which Government have sanctioned the conversion of one of the Secondary grade teacher's posts into that of a Urdu Munshi on Rs.40-2-50.
