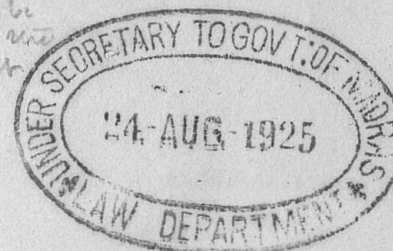

The draft notification under section 6 of the Act may be ordered to be published as recommended by the Board of Revenue. As regards the nominal grant to be paid from Provincial funds to enable acquisition proceedings to be taken, the collector recommends a grant of Rupee 1. It is submitted that the usual grant is only one anna and it would suffice if this is paid in this case. The Director has already recommended the inclusion of this acquisition in the approved list, thus making it eligible for a half-grant. Orders to this effect may also be issued now.

3 After acquisition, the land should be conveyed to the authorities of the Boarding House by a formal deed of conveyance embodying, among other conditions, those laid down in G.O. 134, Home (Education), dated 27th January 1920.

4. The Govt. sanction the inclusion, in the list of approved works maintained in pursuance of G.O. 572, Law (Edn), dated 10-5-22, of the scheme relating to the above acquisition at an estimated cost of Rs. 1479-2-7. While this approval does not convey any guarantee of grant, it will render the scheme eligible for a grant under the Grant-in-Aid-Code, if and when funds become available, provided that all the conditions prescribed in the Code are duly complied with.
