Sir,

D.V.Narasimham, Acting Jailer, Sub Jail, Russelkonda was exempted from the provision of article 1 of Public Service Notification in G.O.No. 861, Law (Education) dated the 6th June 1921, for employment as clerk in the Jail Department in the scale of pay of Rs. 35-60. Prior to his exemption, he was permanently exempted from the operation of the Examination rules for employment in the clerical grade on pay not exceeding Rs. 35/- per mensem. His permanent pay as Jailer, Sub Jail, Nellore is Rs. 45-8-0 and he draws Rs. 72/- as officiating Jailer, Sub Jail, Russellkonda. He has been working in the Sub Jail, Russellkonda since the 20th January 1922, and has discharged his duties satisfactorily. As the post of Jailer, Sub Jail, Russelkonda has

fallen permanently vacant it is proposed to confirm ----
