Sir,

I have the honour to state that according to G.O.No. 737 Law (Education) dated 29th May 1923, the staff employed in the Government Secondary and Training Schools consists only of school Assistants and Secondary Grade teachers. The scale for the latter in the time scale is Rs 45-3-90 with a Selection on Rs 100 for 20% of the cadre. The appointment of teachers in the ordinary grade of Secondary grade teachers vests in the Inspectresses vide G.O.No. 966 Law (Education) dated 9th July 1923.

2. Thus it will be seen that there is no provision whatever for the existence of elementary grade teachers

on the staff of Government Secondary and Training Schools. Accordingly ~~xxx~~ steps were taken to transfer the already existing elementary grade teachers to elementary schools. But in respect of those that could not be so transferred for want of vacancies, the pay of such teachers in the time scale was fixed according to the scale sanctioned for elementary grade teachers in G.O.No. 1577 Law (Education) dated 18th December 1922 as a similar procedure was ordered to be adopted in the case of training schools for masters-Vide G.O.No. 787 Law (Education) dated 28th June 1922-Para 1(iv).

3. In the case of officiating appointments in the cadre of secondary grade teachers caused by the absence on leave &c of secondary grade teachers however, Inspectresses, for want of a sufficient number of secondary grade women teachers, have appointed elementary grade teachers and allowed them to draw pay according to the scale sanctioned for Elementary grade teachers.

I am of opinion that this procedure is ultra vires as elementary grade teachers cannot be appointed to secondary grade posts unless they are exempted from the provisions of Article 3 of the Public Service Notification and Inspectresses are not empowered to grant such exemptions for appointments in the cadre of secondary grade teachers which carry a pay of Rs 45-3-90.

With reference to para 10 of Article 5 of the Public Service Notification, I can grant such exemption but in such a case the pay of the teachers exempted should not be less than Rs 45 per mensem as under Fundamental Rule 35 the local Government alone has got such power. To grant such teachers the full pay of Rs 45/- would be too much not to speak of the discontent it would cause among the elementary grade teachers already in service.

I therefore request that you will be so good as

to obtain the sanction of Government to allow teachers of lower grade qualifications, if appointed to posts included in the cadre of secondary teachers, to draw only pay sanctioned for the cadre to which they belong.
