The proposal to include the post of Assistant employed in the Government Secondary Training class at Saidapet in the cadre of school Assistants does not involve any extra expenditure during 1925-26 as the incumbent of the post after its inclusion in the cadre will have to be started only on Rs.75 (the minimum in the scale of Rs.75-5-100; 100-10-150; 150-10-250 approved for School Assistants).

3. Provision for the salary of the three Temporary Assistants has been inserted in the Civil Budget estimate for 1925-26.
