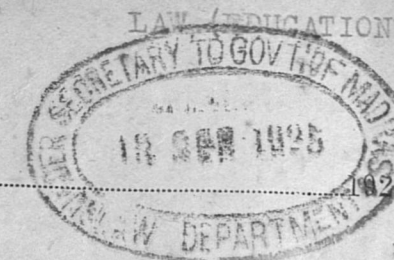

LAW (EDUCATION) Department.

Sir,

With reference to G.O. No. 1534, Law (Education) dated 4th September 1925 sanctioning the opening of a temporary measure, of a secondary training class in the Government Higher Elementary Training School for Masters at Chicacole, I have the honour to state that as already explained in my letter R.O.C. No. 2311 C/22, dated 26th September 1924, the training class is intended for the training of untrained teachers employed in schools in the Ganjam and Vizagapatam Districts and Chicacole was selected for the location of the class on the recommendation of Mr Tyson, who suggested that the lower forms of the Municipal High School in the locality might be used for practising purposes by the students under training in the Secondary Training class. Educational Officer Mr. Sivarama Ratho reports that the lower forms of the above Municipal High School do not contain Oriya classes and that they cannot be used for practising purposes. In view of this and in view also of the fact that the training class is to be a mixed one for Telugus and Oriyas, he considers that it is desirable to locate it at Berhampore. I have therefore the honour to request that in modification of the orders issued in the G.O. referred to above, Government will be pleased to accord sanction for the opening of the class in the Government ^{Higher} Elementary Training ~~xxxx~~ school at Berhampore. The lower forms of the Kallikota College which contain both Oriya and Telugu classes, are proposed to be used for observation and practical work, and the District Educational Officer reports that the authorities of the college have no objection to the proposal. The training class will be accommodated in the existing building of the Government Higher Elementary Training school in the locality.

2. The Government Higher Elementary School at Berhampore has besides a Physical Training Instructor, a Drawing Master on its staff and if the secondary training class is attached to the above institution there will be no need for a separate Drawing master for the new training class. The District Educational Officer also reports that no expenditure need be incurred on furniture as the existing furniture in the Government Higher Elementary Training school will be adequate and sufficient to meet the additional requirements. In these circumstances I recommend that the sanction accorded in the G.O. referred to in para 1 above to the following items may ^{be} cancelled:-

- (i) The employment of a drawing master on Rs 25
- (ii) Furniture , 300

3. As the year is already far advanced I am in anticipation of Government sanction, issuing orders to the District Educational Officer, Ganjam to take steps to open the training class at Berhampore immediately and

Para 2 of the draft order overleaf:

A supplementary demand for Rs. 3600 was voted by the Legislative Council in the August 1925 session for the opening of a secondary training class in the Govt. Higher Elementary Training School for Masters, Chicacole. This included a sum of Rs. 500 on account of the pay of a drawing master (Rs. 200) and purchase of furniture (Rs. 300) which are now proposed to be excluded. - Para 2 of draft. This saving of Rs. 500 may, it is submitted, be resumed on receipt of a copy of the proceedings overleaf with notes.
