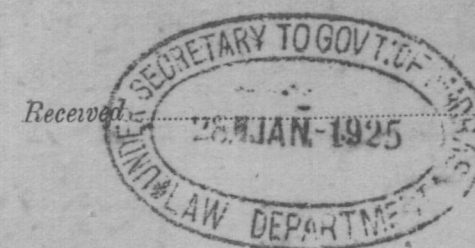

Sir,

In G.O.No. MIs 867 Law (Education) dated 28th May 1924, sanction was accorded to the inclusion in the list of approved works of the construction of a science block for the Sri Minakshi College, Chidambaram, at an estimated cost of Rs.1,71,850/-.

2. The building is now in course of construction and the Correspondent of the college requests permission for certain deviations in the approved structure. He reports that all the deviations have been planned in the presence of the Executive Engineer, South Arcot, and have had his approval.

3. I submit herewith a copy of the Correspondent's letter dated 2nd October 1924 explaining the nature of the deviations together with an extract of the remarks of the Executive Engineer thereon and an estimate for Rs.760 for the extra cost involved in the deviations.

4. The Dy. Consulting Architect approves the above estimate. I therefore recommend that Government be pleased to sanction the inclusion of the building in the list of approved works at an increased cost of Rs.172,610.

Letter from the Correspondent and Principal, Sri 3
Minakshi College, Chidambaram to the Director of Public Instruction, dated 2nd October 1924.

I have the honour to request permission for the following deviations and improvements in the structure. Every one of these has been planned in the presence of the Executive Engineer, South Arcot, and has had his approval when he last inspected the buildings on the 21st September.

Ground floor.

(1) Making an arch 6 feet wide on the Northern wall of the stair case room and provide it with iron doors (in the place of a doorway provided in the plan)

(2) On the southern walls of the lecture rooms, one doorway 5' x 2½' in the centre on each wall and the conversion of three ventilators 4' x 4' on each wall into five ventilators 4' x 2', three on the top and two at the bottom to allow light and air into the rooms below the gallery.

First floor.

(1) A door 6' x 3' in the centre of the South wall of the dark room as the Science staff wants this door for going out for manipulating sunlight let into the room.

(2) A doorway and two windows uniform ^{with the others} ~~that the others~~ in the building of the south wall of the Intermediate Physics Lecture Hall. The Executive Engineer says that this will add much to the appearance and comfort of the lecture room.

Flues. On the advice of Mr. W. Earlam Smith, Professor of Chemistry in the Presidency College, I am substituting glazed stoneware pipes for iron pipes for flues as these were considered better. I am adding also pilasters 9" thick at the flue points in order to strengthen the wall as required by the Engineering authorities consulted.
