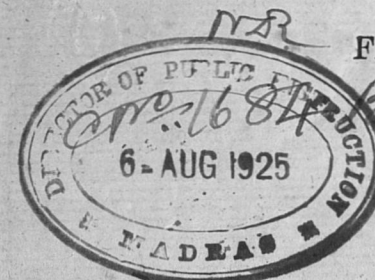

G.O.No.65 Law (Education) dated 19-1-1925-

levy of education tax in Calicut Taluk.

I have the honour to invite a reference to the above G.O. in which Government sanctioned the levy of the tax subject to the condition that the Taluk Board contributes every year from its general revenues to the elementary education fund a sum not less than Rs.3000/- and that the proceeds of the tax and the equivalent Government contribution are utilised solely for the expansion of elementary education and not diverted for the maintenance of existing schools or for revising the pay of teachers. This latter condition works hard on the Taluk Board for the reasons shown below.

In their Order No.2203 L and M., dated 23-6-1925 Government sanctioned the amalgamation of the Kurumbranad Taluk Board with the Calicut Taluk Board

with

with effect from 1-7-1925. In sanctioning the levy of education tax for the Kurumbranad Taluk Board no such restriction has been imposed vide G.O.No. 1105 Law (Ed) dated 22-9-1923. As it is, this Board has to keep separate accounts of receipts and charges of the education tax and the equivalent contribution from the Calicut Taluk. Moreover the teachers in the Calicut Taluk are given a starving pay of Rs.14/- per mensem. At the meeting held on 16th July 1925 the Taluk Board considered this difference in pay under the same Board as anomalous and also quite necessary to raise it to Rs.18/- per mensem. Accordingly the Board raised the pay of teachers in the Calicut Taluk also to Rs.18/- per mensem from 1-7-1925.

Every effort will be made to expand elementary education by opening of new schools wherever necessary and possible in the new Taluk area as a whole.

In these circumstances I request that Government may be pleased to remove this restriction imposed in the levy of the education tax. I understand that no such restriction has been imposed while sanctioning the tax in any other Taluk in this District.

The Govt. are unable to relax the condition specified in G.O.No. 65 Law Education, dated 19th January 1925, that the proceeds of the education tax and the equivalent Govt. contribution should be utilized solely for the expansion of elementary education and should not be diverted for the maintenance of existing schools or for revising the pay of -- teachers. This condition applies to the tax levied by the other taluk boards also though it was not specifically stated in G.O.No. 1105 Law (Education), dated 22nd September 1922.
