The Principal, Presidency College, Madras requests the supply of the two marginally noted German periodicals

2. Zoologischer Anzeiger

which the college was receiving before 1914. They were ordered to be dis-

continued by Government in their order No. 681, Home (Education), dated 29th July 1918 as a measure of war economy on the recommendation of the then Principal, supported by this office.

2. The Professor of Zoology, Presidency College states that the periodicals should be brought up to date and continued. The Chairman, Periodicals Committee, University Library, Madras who was presumably consulted by the Principal, states that both are periodicals of the highest importance

Under the orders of Sir Alexander Cardew, the the
Finance Member, enquiries were instituted in all depart-
ments whether any retrenchment in the supply of periodic-
als to themselves, to officers etc. subordinate to them
was possible. The D.P.I. in that connection agreed to
the discontinuance of certain periodicals in which the
two now referred to by him were included and their
supply was accordingly stopped.

2. The Director, at the instance of the Principal
Presidency College, now requests that the supply of the
two periodicals to the College may be renewed with
effect from 1-4-1926. He reports that the college
was ~~receiving~~ receiving the periodicals even before
1914 and that they are regarded by the Chairman, Perio-
dical Committee, University Library, as "periodicals of
the highest importance which are not otherwise available
in Madras....." The annual subscriptions amount
to nearly £12 and £3 and the Director states that he
would include necessary provision in the Budget Estimate
for 1926-27. As the amount is small and is due to
normal growth of expenditure it is ~~in for consideration~~ ^{is doubtful}
whether provision should be made in Part II of the
budget as proposed by D.P.I.
