Sir,

By G.O. No. *34*, Law (Registration), dated the 20th February 1923 the Government directed that T.S. Sundaram Pillai, an unpassed acting clerk in Palamcottah district should be confirmed as an exceptional case in consideration of his long acting service and efficient work. He was accordingly confirmed as clerk with effect from the 13th March 1923. As, however, the G.O. did not contain orders also exempting the clerk from the examination rules I request that the Government may be pleased to exempt

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him permanently from the provisions of Article 1 of the Public Service Notification so as to enable him to draw increments in the scale of Rs.35-35-1½-50-1-60 subject to the efficiency bar at Rs.50.
