Sir,

The Government of Bihar and Orissa in the Ministry of Education have been considering the new conditions of service for those posts which are now in the Indian Educational Service and would like to ascertain what is being done in this respect in other provinces. Say

I am directed to state that the  
question of the reorganisation of the  
I.E.S. <sup>posts</sup> in this Presidency has not yet  
been considered <sup>It is proposed to</sup> and will be taken up  
after the receipt of the orders of the  
Secretary of State on the recommendations  
of the Lee Commission for the provincia-  
lisation of that service.

2. The time-scale of pay sanction-  
ed for ~~the~~ members of the Madras Educa-  
tional service is Rs. 250-25-500-50-800.  
There is no proposal to revise the scale  
irrespective of any reorganisation which  
may be contemplated in connection with  
the abolition of the I.E.S.
