The Hon'ble Member apparently refers amount placed at the disposal of the District Council, Ramnad, for payment of teaching grant, to aided elementary schools. The provision made in the budget for 1925-26 for payment of teaching grants has not yet been distributed among the several District Educational Councils. In the year 1924-25 a sum of Rs 1,34,268 was placed at the disposal of the District Educational Council, Ramnad, against a sum of Rs 1,18,082 in 1923-24.

The following draft answer is submitted,

Clause (a). The provision made in the budget estimate for 1925-26 for the payment of teaching grants to aided elementary schools has not yet been distributed among the several Dt. Educational Councils. The amount placed at the disposal of the Dt. Educational Council, Ramnad, for the payment of teaching grants in the year 1924-25 was Rs 1,34,268 as against Rs 1,18,082 in 1923-24.
