As regards (b) of the question, if the question has reference to the date of return of completed secondary school leaving certificates with the public examination marks entered therein, the certificates were despatched from the office of the Commissioner for Government Examinations between the 12th and 15th of June in all the three years under consideration. If, however, the information required has reference to the dates on which the preliminary list of certificate holders eligible for admission to college

courses was despatched to schools by the University in 1923, 1924 and 1925, the Registrar of the University will be able to supply the information as he sends out copies of the list to the various institutions.

As regards (c) there was no date fixed any time for the publication of the results and as regards (d) neither the Director nor the Commissioner for Government Examinations is aware of any such inconvenience. There has been no complaint. On the contrary I may say that the School Leaving Certificate Board has passed a number of resolutions expressing their appreciation of the expeditious way in which the tabulation of school leaving certificate marks was done and the promptitude with which the certificates were despatched. Heads of institutions have also expressed their appreciation and I may remark that the work of tabulation and of despatch is of considerable magnitude when it is remembered that the number of certificates was 11,900 in 1923, 12,800 in 1924 and 14,200 in 1925.

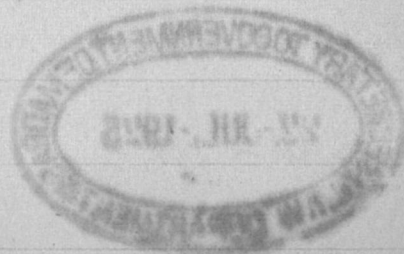
