Sir,

The Elementary Education Fund of this Board has been formed only from 1-4-1925 as per T.B.R. No. 13-A dated 3-1-1925. For years prior to the constitution of the fund, the Board was contributing towards Elementary Education account from the General Account of the Board - as much as was required to wipe off the deficits in the receipts to cover the annual charges. This has been the practice of the Board for several years. The provision in the Budget was utilised as far as was found necessary

necessary and the actuals for a year accordingly varied. The

(D) balance amount viz., Rs.1569/- referred to in the G.O. is one due to such causes and it was not credited to the Elementary Education as no such fund was constituted during 1923-1924 and 1924-1925.

It is not now possible to credit the balance amount referred to as fixed in the G.O. for the following reasons:-

1922-23 - Rs.15,760
1923-24 - 22,603
1924-25 - 19,950
RE - 1923.

(1). The Board had to incur heavy expenditure to bring to order several roads damaged by the unprecedented floods of December 1923.

(2). Another unforeseen expenditure of Rs.8100 and odd had to be incurred towards payment of contribution to the Tinnevelly Municipality for the upkeep of its medical institutions as per G.O. No.346 P.H. dated 14-2-1925.

(3). And a third unforeseen expenditure of Rs.1400 and odd had to be incurred for the cost of forms supplied in excess by the Central Press, Madras. The Board's protest in the matter was of no avail and the amount was adjusted by short credit of land cess due to the Board.

II. Now that an Elementary Education Fund of the Board has been constituted from 1-4-1925, the Board will during the current year contribute its moiety as fixed by Government and as approved by the Board. So I request that the Government may be pleased to reconsider the order and waive the credit of the balance amount Rs.1569/- ordered, in view of its present financial stringency under the circumstances explained above.

III. A copy of the Board's resolution T.B.R. No. 9 dated 31-7-1925 deciding to address the Government again on the subject is enclosed.

In passing order on the Budget Estimate of the Elementary Education Fund under the control of the Taluk Board, Tinnervelly for 1925-26, the Taluk Board was asked to credit a sum of Rs. 1569 being the balance of the contribution payable by the Taluk Board from its own revenues to the ~~ELC~~ Fund for the years 1923-24 & 1924-25.

The Taluk Board represents that the financial condition of the Board is not satisfactory and the payment of the balance may, therefore, be ordered to be waived.

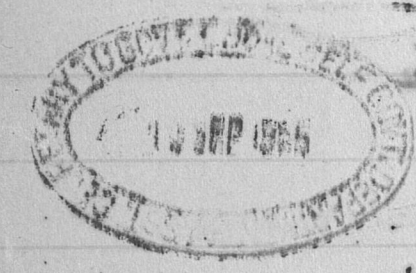

Sept's notes on page 13 of G.O. no. 1070
Law (Edu) & 23.6.25. The general
budget of the taluk board closed
with a balance of Rs 870 only under
the general account against the
prescribed minimum of Rs 1,458.
In order to secure the necessary
balance the Board has been
asked to reduce the provision
made for an expenditure of Rs 5,950
on capital works from the
general account. It may be
possible for the Board (to further
reduce this provision by Rs 1,569
in order to pay the arrears contribution
to Ely. edu. for 1923-24. ^{By} the
