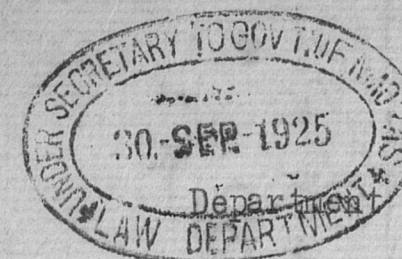

Proposed visit of Mr. F.S.Marvin of St.John's
 College, Oxford.

Sir,

I am directed to say that Mr. F.S. Marvin of St.John's College, Oxford, who has recently retired from the Home Civil Service (Board of Education), will be visiting India this winter. He has done a considerable amount of essay-writing for the Press, his best known works being perhaps "The Living Past" and "The Century of Hope". He will be accompanied by another Englishman who was a professor in Ceylon and is now at a Californian University. The two visitors intend producing jointly a volume on their return to England. The Government of India will be glad if steps can be taken to put Mr. Marvin in touch with educational authorities if he requests any assistance.

2. Mr. Marvin is being asked to communicate his requirements to you in advance in case he wishes to visit the Madras Presidency. The Government of India have no information about his plans or itinerary.
