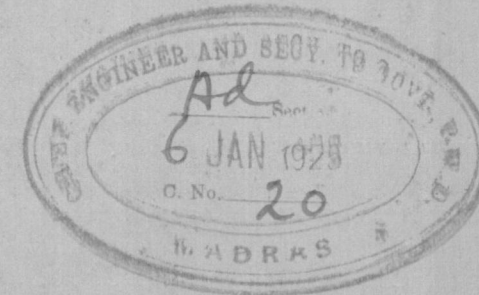

Sir,

I forward herewith for favourable consideration and orders a petition dated 4th December 1924 from M. Durei-swami Pillai Officiating tracer of this office, requesting that he may be recommended for permanent exemption from the Lower Subordinate test of the College of Engineering, Madras, with a view to his being employed as a draftsman in the P.W.D.

2. His pay is now Rs.41 in the Rs.30-1-45 grade, he has been in continuous temporary service in this Circle since 8th June 1910 and his temporary service till now (22-12-24) amounts to 13 years and 11 days, omitting leave on loss of pay and medical certificate. His age is 36 years and his educational qualifications are given in the application for

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exemption from the Examination rules, in the prescribed form enclosed.

3. It is seen from the technical examinations passed by the tracer, noted in the above application, that he has passed all the examinations, except the Building Drawing and Estimating in the Advanced grade prescribed for the group certificate in Mechanical Drawing -- which would entitle him to employment as a draftsman, without exemption, according to the Public Service Notification. The above examination (Building Drawing and Estimating Advanced Grade) has been abolished and he is therefore unable to again appear for it. But it will be seen that he has passed that examination in the Elementary grade and also some other examinations not prescribed for the Group Certificate, viz, items 3, 7 & 9 noted in Col.I of the application enclosed.

4. The tracer has been actually doing the duties of an Assistant Draftsman in this office with success and his disposals are always satisfactory. He deserves to be permanently exempted from the Lower Subordinate test for employment as a draftsman and I recommend that - this may be done as was done in the case of two of his seniors in this Circle noted below:-

Most Honoured Sir,

1. I, N.Duraiswami Pillai, tracer, Circle Office respectfully beg to submit the following few lines for your sympathetic consideration and favourable orders.

2. I, have studied up to the Matriculation standard and have undergone two years' training during 1906-07--08, in the Lower subordinate Class in the Engineering ~~sch~~ school at Midnapur, affiliated to the Sibpur Civil Engineering College, Calcutta. Owing to an attack of Malaria at the time of my examination at the Sibpur College I did not fare well in the practical examination, in Smithy and Carpentry though I have passed in the theoretical portions. Due to the continuance of the illness for a long time I was not able to reappear for the examination there and complete it. However, I worked at, and developed my knowledge in Engineering subjects when my brother M.R.Ry., N.Kandaswamy Pillai Avl., was in charge of a sub division in the first circle.

3. In the year 1910 I entered P.W.D, as a tracer in the T.R.S.Division and I have put in a continued service of about 15 years. In view of my having undergone training in the Engineering school affiliated to the Sibpur College I did not think for a long time for appearing for the Government Technical examinations. After the issue however, of G.O, No.541, Educational, dated --

19-5-1915, prescribing 3 Elementary tests for a Tracer's post. I qualified myself and obtained certificates in certain other Technical subjects, a list of which I give below:--

1. Geometrical Drawing (Inter). ✓
2. Earth-work and Road-making (Ele). ✓
3. Building Materials and Construction (Inter). ✓
4. Building Drawing and Estimating (Ele). ✓
5. Machine drawing (Inter). ✗
6. Mensuration (Ele). ✓
7. Freehand and Outline Drawing (Ele). ✓
8. Hydraulics and Irrigation works (Inter). ✓
9. Hydraulics and Engineering Group certificate.

I have also passed in all the subjects prescribed for a draftsman except in Building Drawing (Advanced), which however, has now been abolished.

4. I have acted at times as draftsman in short vacancies getting necessary exemptions. But to my misfortune owing to retrenchment in the P.W.D, many of the thrown-out hands had to be provided for and my claims are being overlooked. As a matter of fact I am doing now Draftsman's work and the present S.D.I, and the personal Assistant may say what they think of my capacity and work.

5. Two of the tracers in this circle have been permanently exempted from passing the Lower subordinate test and are all employed in long standing temporary vacancies of Draftsman. Besides, four of the seven thrown-out subordinates are exempted persons and they are holding permanent posts now.

6. Further, although I have put in a continuous service of 15 years I have not yet been confirmed in the Department which is acting detrimentally to my interest

interest as this will be especially seen from men with less service and lesser qualifications from other circles having been confirmed thus having precedence over me.

7. I respectfully beg to request, therefore, that your honour may be pleased to take into consideration my training in the Engineering school affiliated to the Sibpur Civil Engineering College (Bengal) in the years 1906--1908, my experience of 15 years in the P.W.D, during which I also at times acted as Draftsman and my technical qualifications, to get me permanent exemption from passing the Lower Subordinate Test to give me a Draftsman's post in long standing vacancy and to confirm me in the department.

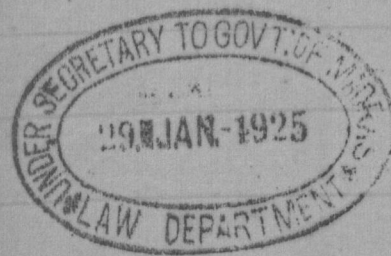
