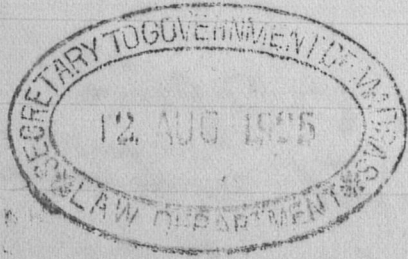

My dear Krishnamachari,

Your letter No. 2958A-1 dated 14th August 1925 regarding Mrs. Ewart reached me on Friday evening and irrespective of the question of posting her as an Inspectress of schools it was necessary to allow her to rejoin her permanent post as if it was decided to post her as an Inspectress it would take some time to arrange. It is 10 years since Mrs. Ewart has done any inspection work and in a little over a year's time she will retire from service. I do not think there will be any advantage gained by posting her as an Inspectress, nor do I know of the 'special qualifications' she has for inspection work. Moreover to post her as an Inspectress would involve the reversion of Miss Schofield who is at present acting as Inspectress in the Southern Circle. I may find it desirable to recommend the reversion on the score of health but would prefer to defer a decision on this to a later date.

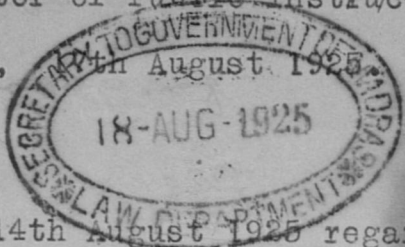
