With reference to your communication R.O.C. No. 1490 D/24, dated 19-6-25, I have the honour to state as follows:

The Superiors of the Madura Mission of which the Catholic Mission, Palamcottah is a part, have been contemplating for some time past the amalgamation of the three Societies: St. Joseph's College, Trichinopoly, Loyola College, Madras, St. Xavier's - College, Palamcottah. The matter has to be referred to the - higher authorities of the Society of Jesus in Europe. It will take a long time for the matter to be settled. Under the circumstances, I request you to be so good as to exempt me from submitting a draft mortgage deed for the building grant sanctioned, (vide Director's Proceedings R.O.C. No.1490 D/24, dated 3-9-24), and allow me to draw the amount sanctioned.

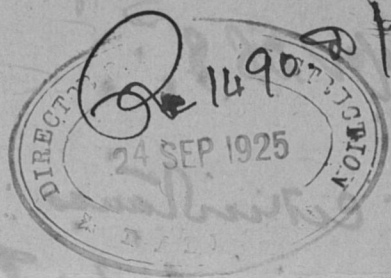

On 27-8-1925 I authorised the payment of a grant of Rs.38116/- towards the construction of a new building for the college classes of St.Xavier's College, Palamcottah. In para 4 of the order sanctioning payment I stated as follows:-

"The management will be ~~exempted~~ for the time being from the execution of the usual mortgage deed on the understanding that the deed will be executed after the Societies of the St.Joseph's College, Trichinopoly, Loyola College, Madras and the St.Xavier's College, Palamcottah are amalgamated".

Father Lebeau also discussed with me the question of executing the mortgage deed and he informed me of the position. I told him what I would do as regards exemption, i.e. grant temporary exemption but I told him that I thought it ~~will~~ be far more satisfactory both from their own point of view and from the point of view of Government if as the result of a reference to Europe the three Societies at Trichinopoly, Madras and Palamcottah were amalgamated and arrangements made whereby they could execute mortgages for building grants. In the case of all these ^{colleges} ~~cases~~ large grants have been given in the past or are pending payment. It does not seem to me desirable that, simply because there may be some difficulties involved, ~~that~~ the authorities of the colleges should be relieved of the necessity of taking any steps to regularise their management so far as their financial relations with Government are concerned. It is requested that the Secretary will be so good as to put the position as now explained

explained before the Hon. the Minister and ask him kindly to inform me whether he desires that the Palamcottah College should be exempted once and for all from executing a mortgage deed. It is submitted that I do not recommend it and that I do not see how the execution of a mortgage deed in any case can be demanded if it is dispensed with in this.

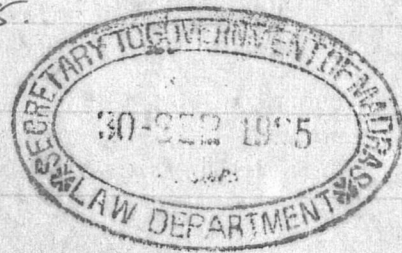

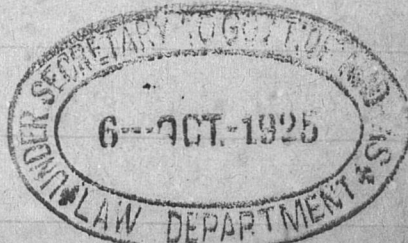
