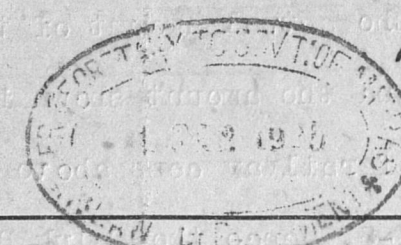
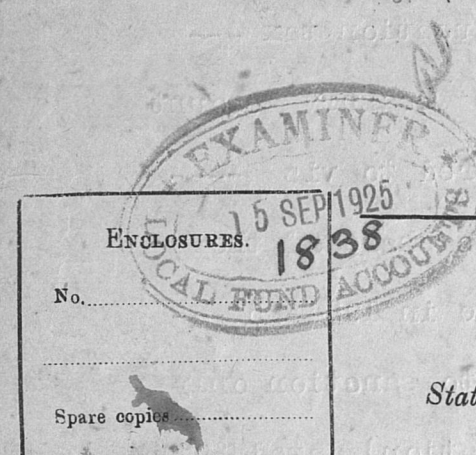

Sir,

I have the honour to state that under section 34 of the Elementary Education Act my Taluk Board commenced levying of the Education tax from 1921-22 in which year the said tax amounted to Rs 3215/-. Next year i.e in 1922-23, Government sanctioned a contribution of Rs 3215 in their order No 1582 Law (Education) dated 19th December 1922 under section 37 of the Act. During 1922-23 the amount of tax under section 34 of the Act came to Rs 12,559; but in 1923-24 Government sanctioned a contribution of only Rs 8742-11-0 in their two orders viz G.O.No 686 Law (Education) dated 16th May 1923 Rs 2411/- and G.O.No 1595 Mis Law (Education) dated 12th

November 1923 Rs 6331-11-0. In calculating the above sum, the railway cess of Rs 3815-10-10 collected in April and May 1921 and credited -- During 1922-23 as Education tax and ordered to be refunded in G.O.No 181 L & M Mis dated 19th January 1923 was deducted on the ground that no contribution under section 37 of the Act was due on that amount. So far, the Taluk Board's share of the Government contribution under --- section 37 of the Act has been fully realized.

2. During 1923-24 the actual amount of the Education tax --- collected was Rs 8486-9-1 and the amount shown in the Treasury Account after deducting the refund of railway cess above referred to viz ---- Rs 3815-10-10 was Rs 4670-14-3. Hence the Taluk Board's share of the Government contribution under section 37 of the Act due in 1924-25 --- should be Rs 8486-9-0 but the Government were pleased to sanction only a sum of Rs 6557/- in their order No 653 Mis Law (Education) dated 29th April 1924. Accordingly my Taluk Board is still entitled to a balance of Rs 1929-9-0 which I request that the Government may be pleased to sanction at an early date.

The sum of Rs.4,670-14-3 reported in this office No.3654, dated 15th September 1924, represents the net amount of collections, after deducting the amount of unauthorised collections of Rs.3,815-10-9 which had been deducted from the contribution paid by Government in Government Order No.1595, Mis. 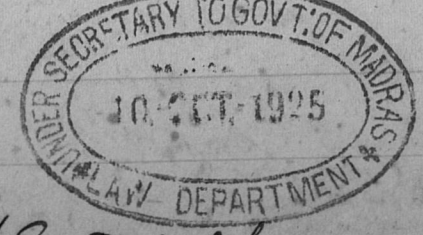
