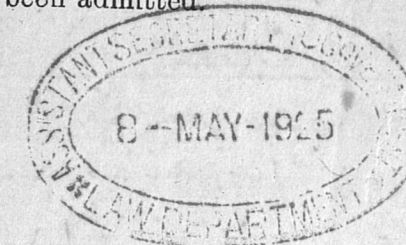

Law (Education) Department.

Fee concessions to pupils belonging to the depressed classes are governed by rule 92 of the Madras Educational Rules. Under this rule the pupils in question need pay only one-half of the standard rates of fees in secondary schools and colleges provided they are poor. The Hon'ble member refers to more liberal concessions. It is not clear what exactly he has in mind. He may perhaps be referred to

- (1) G.O.No.707 Law (Education), dated 5-5-1925 in which the list of officers empowered to grant certificates of poverty has been enlarged and
- (2) G.O.No.855 Law (Education), dated 19-5-1925 in which it has been laid down that pupils belonging to the depressed classes ~~but who~~ but who have become converts to Christianity do not forfeit their ~~the~~ eligibility to the fee concession to ^{which} they would have been eligible but for their conversion.
