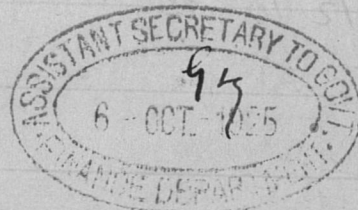

2. The draft order follows the precedent in G.O.No.1483 Law(Education), dated 19-9-1924. Under sub-rule 2 to F.R.47 the amount of the fee to be paid must be fixed with due regard to the value of the service rendered. Since the date of G.O.1483Law(edn.), dated 19-9-1924, Warden allowances to be paid from general

revenues have been systematised in G.O.1344Law(Edn.) dated 6-8-1925. The principles of that G.O. have to be followed as a matter of policy even when the fee is paid from sources other than general revenues as otherwise any excessive amount admitted for payment from private funds with the sanction of Government will be cited for comparison with any lower rate allowed ^{in cases where} payment is ^{made} to be from general revenues and it may help to advance extravagant claims. In the present case it is not known whether the Deputy Warden is allowed any free-quarters on the scale sanctioned in G.O.1344 Law(Education) dated 6-8-1925 the proposed sum of Rs.50 p.m. can be accepted provided (i) the Deputy Warden does not enjoy free-quarters,

(ii) the Hostel has not less than 75 students, and

(iii) the Government servant proposed for Deputy Wardenship is a member of M.E.S.

Law (Education) may be requested to furnish detailed information on these three points.
