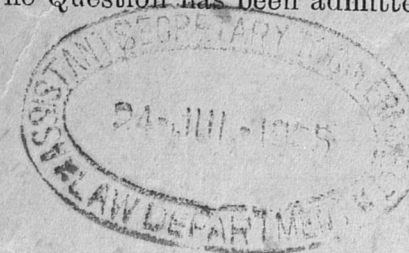

Law (E.A. n) Depth:

The reference in the question is apparently to that part of the Retirement Committee's recommendation which related to the transfer of the work of training teachers to the ordinary schools for general education and the extension of the subsidy system. The following draft answer is suggested for consideration:—

Committee recommended that ^{Desirable to attach training} ~~schools might be attached to schools which~~ ^{schools which} provide for general education, and ~~that~~ ^{being} subventions might be paid to meet the cost of such classes instead of ~~open~~ ^{the training} separate training institutions being opened under Government management.

The D. P. C. was asked to submit proposals to give effect to the suggestion wherever possible. Towards the end of last year the Director reported that in response to a circular issued by him to Dist. Ed. Coms., Dist. Sec. Education Boards and ~~Super~~ Inspecting officers of the Dept. inviting proposals for attaching training classes

to Schools under private management he received eight schemes. Seven of these had to be rejected ^{mainly} on the ground that facilities for training in the districts concerned ^{were} ~~are~~ fairly sufficient or that the percentage of trained teachers in them ^{was} not below the Presidency average. The remaining ~~one~~ scheme, namely, of attaching a Secondary training class to the High School, Srirangam, is under consideration.
