In submitting herewith a copy of the letter No.8 dated 11-6-1925 received from the General Secretary, Karnatak Lingayat Education Society, Belgaum, requesting a free supply of certain Sanskrit publications of the Government Oriental Manuscripts Library, Madras, I have the honour to state that the Curator reports that the Society is doing excellent work in the Bombay Karnatak, by way of spreading education and oriental culture. Besides, the Director of Public Instruction, Bombay, whom I consulted in the matter, states that the Society is managing two High Schools and one or two Anglo-Vernacular schools. Its object is mainly to spread

education among the Lingayat community. The Society is modeled on the Deccan Education Society and is a respectable society doing useful work.

2. The Curator recommends the supply of the following publications of which sufficient copies are reported to be available:-
