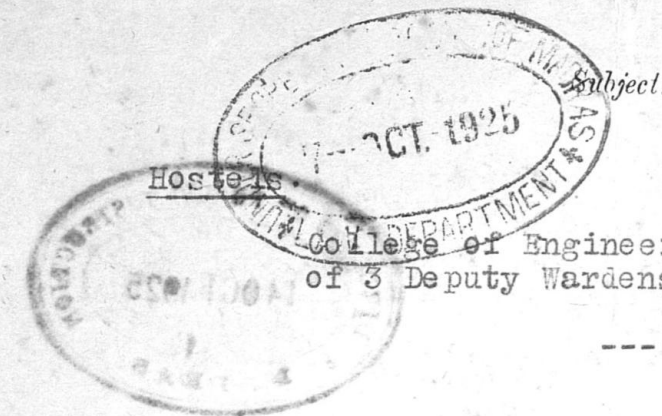

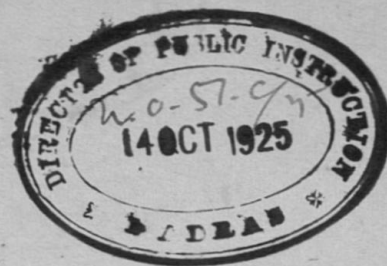
Sir,

I have the honour to state that in para.6 of
G.O. No.1344 Law (Education) dated 6-8-1925 it is stated
that the Principal of the College of Engineering, Guindy
will be assisted by 3 Deputy Wardens so long as the strength
of the hostel does not fall below 300. As the present
strength of the hostel is 177, only 2 Deputy Wardens
would appear admissible. I have the honour to enquire
whether in case all the 3 Deputy Wardens are continued
I may divide the allowance due to 2 Deputy Wardens i.e.,
Rs.100/- among the 3 Deputy Wardens.

Hostel - College of Engineering, Guindy - Three
Deputy Wardens - Continuance.

Under paragraph 6 of G.O.No.1344 Law (Educa-
tion), dated 6-8-1925, three Deputy Wardens are allow-
able for the hostel attached to the College of Engi-
neering, Guindy, if the strength of the hostel is
not below 300. The remuneration sanctioned for each
of the Deputy Wardens, if they are members of the
Madras Educational Service or of a service correspond-
ing to it, is Rs.50 a month. The Director reports
that ^{as} the strength of the hostel at present is only 177
two wardens would appear to be admissible and enquires
whether in case he retains all the three Deputy Wardens
it will be in order to divide the allowance due to
two officers (Rs.100) among three officers. It is
^{Submitted} that on principle it is objectionable to countenance
such a distribution as it would mean that the rate of
remuneration for Madras Educational Service ^{Deputy} Wardens
has been pitched a little too high by the Government.
For orders whether the Director may be given a reply
in the negative.

The question should be
viewed from the point of
view of the needs of the hostel.
Does a strength of 177 require
the onerous provision of three Deputy Wardens.
We have held that two would be sufficient
+ we have tried the rate of remuneration
with reference to the duties to be discharged
we may stick to the rates prescribed. The
adjustment proposed may lead to incon-
sistent results. It may not be desirable to allow
offers to be made with reference to remuneration.

The point was not presented as fully by my office as was intended. In the case of this particular college I am in somewhat of a quandary. Of the three Deputy wardens two are European officers who have been discharging the duties of deputy warden for a long time and the question of deciding which of these two officers should officiate in the future as deputy warden presented a difficulty---a difficulty which I wished to resolve in consultation with the permanent Principal; but as there is force in what is stated in the Secretariat note I shall ~~address~~ ^{act} in accordance with the acting Principal's proposals, preserving to myself liberty to approach Government again later if, after consultation with Mr. Cartwright, such a course is found to be necessary.
