I have the honour to submit below a scheme for the introduction of weaving in the Board Elementary School, Lalapet under the Chidambaram Taluk Board.

2. Instruction is proposed to be given to about 45 pupils of standards IV and V of the Board Elementary School, Lalapet in sections of about 12 pupils at a time, each section receiving 2 half-days instruction per week

3. The scheme has been scrutinized by Mr. Porrett and the recurring and non recurring charges are estimated at Rs.430 and Rs.952 respectively as per details noted in the margin.
