I have the honour to address Government regarding the reduction of the number of the various types of locks and keys that are now in use in the Museum and the Connemara Library. At present there is no order or uniformity in the locks of the book cases in the library. The result is that locks are continually being damaged through attempts to use wrong keys and a large proportion are constantly out of order. With a view to having uniform locks for

different groups of cases and thus reducing the number of keys in charge of each of the Assistants in order to facilitate immediate access to the books and ^{to the} articles in the show cases, I have prepared a list of the principal types of locks now in use and on enquiry of ~~the~~ ^{Workshops} the Public Works Department find that a sum of Rs. 1024/- is required for ~~executing~~ replacing those which are out of order or not of one of the types which can be retained. This expenditure can be met from the grant under Non Contract Contingencies - Miscellaneous and the work done by the Public Works ^{Workshops} Department either in full or in part this year as funds for the greater part and perhaps the whole can be made available. If funds from the grant for the whole work are not available this year the remaining work will be done next year. As under item 51 of Appendix F of the Madras Treasury Manual Vol. II the sanction of Government is necessary to incur expenditure of the sum of Rs. 1024/- I request that sanction may be accorded for the same.
